CABIN CHARTER 2018

Tour 1



Day 1: Saturday. Castellammare Di Stabia, at 5.00pm the check-in procedure takes place, then accommodation in the cabins, relaxing dinner on shore in one of the premises of Castellammare, or on board to meet the skipper and other fellow travelers. Overnight on board.

Day 2: Sunday. 10.00 am After breakfast, departure from Castellammare for the Island of Procida, one of the three islands of the Bay of Naples. Its coasts, in some low and sandy areas, give life to several bays, which offer shelter to the navigation. Much of its coastline is protected by the natural reserve “Regno di Nettuno”. The fish is a true first of Procida: every afternoon, around 16.00, the fisherman’s boats arrive at the port of Marina Grande with fish always fresh. So we could take the opportunity to buy some fresh squid to prepare the typical stuffed squid* on board.

Day 3: Monday. Sailing to Ischia, also called Isola Verde (Green Island), full of beaches where you can swim in the thermal waters that go back to the surface. An afternoon spent in Sant'Angelo, an exclusive destination to do some shopping or stop in the ‘piazzetta’ for an aperitif. You can dine in one of the island's premises to taste the typical ‘Coniglio all’Ischitana’ (rabbit speciality) * or simply prepare the La Zingara * on board.

Day 4: Tuesday. Sailing to Capri, also called Isola Azzurra. The coast of the island is jagged with numerous caves and coves that alternate with steep cliffs. The most famous is the Blue Grotto. From Anacapri with the chairlift we can climb Mount Solaro and enjoy the view of the whole bay, then stop to see the romantic Villa Di San Michele and visit Via Camerelle, famous shopping street of luxury and get to the spectacular lookout overlooking the Faraglioni. According to the weather conditions is possible to dine on board (scialatielli alla Nerano or caprese salad *) or spend the evening in the ‘Piazzetta’.

Day 5: Wednesday. Amalfi. "For the Amalfitans who will go to heaven, will be a day like any other" (Renato Fucini).

Magically suspended between the turquoise sea and the blue sky, the Amalfi Coast has been designated a World Heritage Site by the UNESCO, and is mentioned as "an extraordinary example of Mediterranean landscape". The picturesque town of Amalfi is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Italy. The most famous monument is the Cathedral, which houses among other things the enchanting Cloister of Paradise, to be visited absolutely. Among staircases and alleys we go in search of a local that prepare a dish at the base of 'Colatura di Alici' *.

Day 6: Thursday. Sailing back to Positano. Positano is an ancient fishing village, that rises in a beautiful and picturesque panoramic position, is rich in beaches such as San Pietro Laurito, Arienzo and La Porta, which can be reached mainly by sea. The typical, and many stairways of the village, which from the sea bring higher and higher, are full of small clothing stores - famous Moda Positano, typical products of local gastronomy, and crafts. For those who want to continue the night on the land, we recommend one of Positano's most famous places: Music on the Rock. Those who stay on board can prepare a delicious Frittura di Pesce *.

Day 7: Friday. After breakfast on board, full of emotions and memories we return to the nautical base of Castellammare Di Stabia by 16.00.
